



Transfer from MSc to PhD Guidelines Alberta Ingenuity Graduate Student Scholarship Award

The Graduate Student Scholarship Guidelines, specify that funding will not extend beyond the 28th month of a master's program.

To continue funding, the following action is required from you:

1. Submit a proof of completion of a Masters degree and proof of admission/registration into a PhD program;
OR
Proof of a switch to a PhD program prior to the completion of a Masters degree.

AND

2. A one-page project description of your PhD research project highlighting the following:
 - goals
 - milestones
 - timelines
 - methodologies
 - potential significance or impact of your research
3. Updated information about your supervisor, other awards held and academic record. You must seek and receive approval in writing from Alberta Innovates–Technology Futures prior to any significant changes to the research as outlined in the approved application. This includes, but is not limited to, changes in supervisor, project, department and program of study.

Final Report Form: If you do not intend to pursue a PhD degree at an Alberta university, you **must** notify Alberta Innovates–Technology Futures six weeks prior to the cancellation/completion date of your award and complete the Student Final Report form located on our website at www.albertainnovates.ca. This report is due one month after your award cancellation /completion date.
